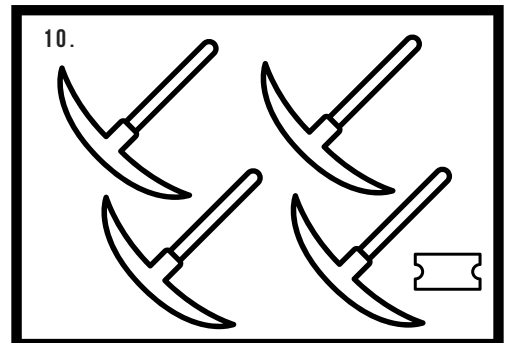
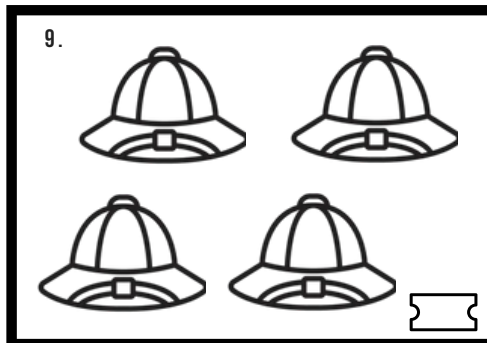
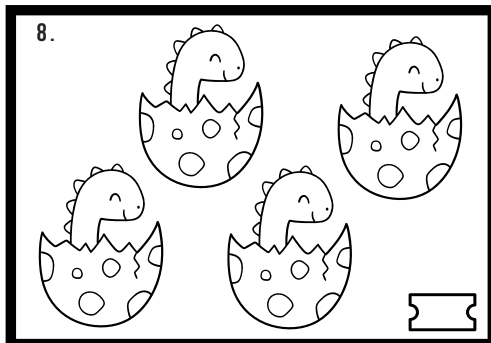
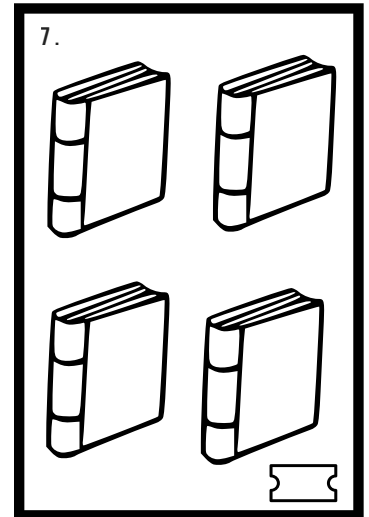
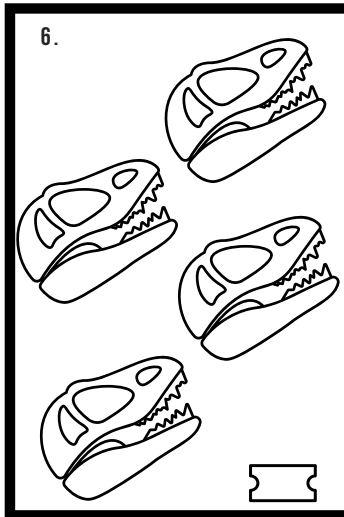
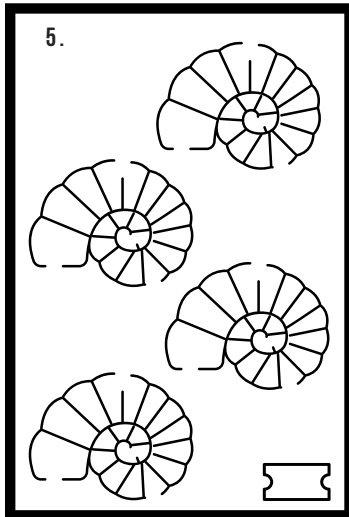
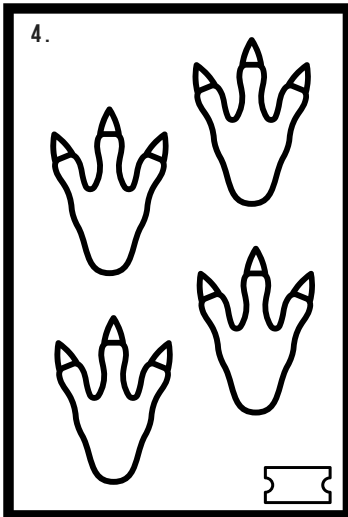
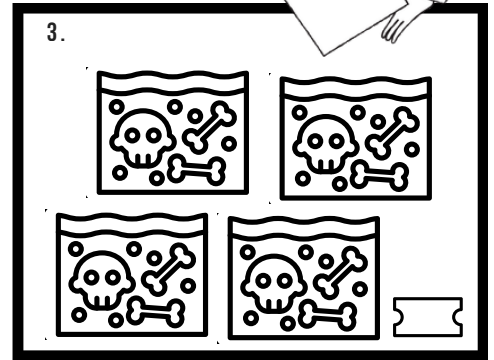
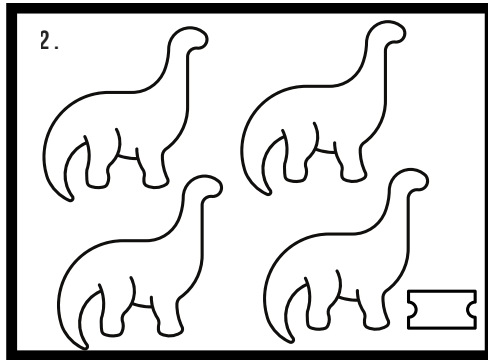
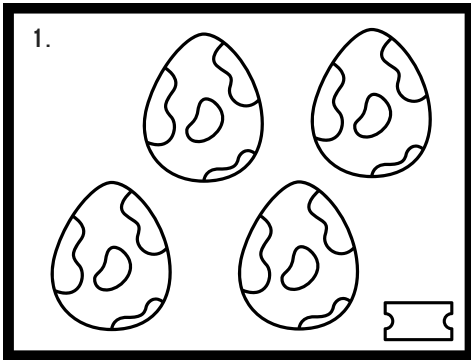
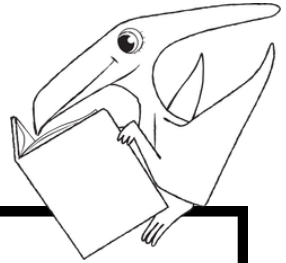
SUMMER READING PROGRAM 2026

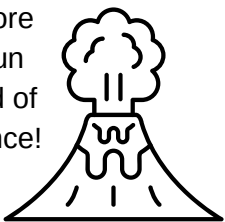
