<h2>Talk</h2> <p>Talking about what you're doing teaches your little one new words.</p>	<p>Identify objects you see outside a car window or during a walk</p>	<p>Say "please" and "thank you"</p>	<p>Tell a family member about your day</p>
<h2>Sing</h2> <p>Singing slows down language so your child can hear individual sounds that make up words.</p>	<p>Sing to your pet (or stuffed animal)</p>	<p>Sing your favorite song</p>	<p>Sing a song about an animal</p>
<h2>Read</h2> <p>Reading books aloud is the single best way to prepare your child to learn to read.</p>	<p>Join a Storytime session at the library*</p>	<p>Look for words on a package of food</p>	<p>Read to a stuffed animal</p>
<h2>Write</h2> <p>Doing fingerplays like "Where is Thumbkin" strengthens little finger muscles.</p>	<p>Draw a picture for a friend or relative</p>	<p>Point out the letters and words in a book</p>	<p>Use sidewalk chalk outside</p>
